- **R-2006-BW:** 6' White (On Blue) 6 Feet Long x 6" Wide x 4" High, Weight = 34 lbs. Produced from 100% blue recycled rubber, with white parallelogram shaped reflective tape.
- **R-2004-Y:** 4' Yellow 4 Feet Long x 6" Wide x 4" High, Weight = 22.5 lbs. Produced from 100% black recycled rubber, with yellow parallelogram shaped reflective tape.
- **R-2003-Y:** 3' Yellow 3 Feet Long x 6" Wide x 4" High, Weight = 17 lbs. Produced from 100% black recycled rubber, with yellow parallelogram shaped reflective tape.

- 1/2" (diameter), 14" (length) rebar spikes for asphalt or lag bolts with washers and metal shields for concrete

What You Need:

- Gloves, safety glasses
- Traffic cones, drums or barricades for securing the site
- Mallet
- Heavy duty electric drill
- 1/2" masonry bit, and if installed with the lag bolts: a masonry bit required for the metal shields consult bit size on side of shield
- A drive socket and a power tool for installation of the lag bolts

Installations Instructions for Asphalt: Installation of parking curbs with spikes (ideal for permanent installation)

Step 1.

Drill 1/2" diameter holes (3 - 4" in depth) in the asphalt through the product's holes.

Step 2.

Drive 1/2" rebar spike (14" long) through the holes in the product. http://www.gnrtech.com/img_gnr/parking_curb/ParkIt_Installation1.gif

Installation Instructions for Concrete: Installation of parking curbs with lag bolts and metal shields (ideal for temporary installation or if removal of car stops is necessary)

Step 1

Use 1/2" or 5/8 lag bolts (6" long). http://www.gnrtech.com/img_gnr/speed_hump_b/EasyRiderSpeedBump_Installation2.gif

Step 2

Drill 1/2" diameter pilot holes (3 - 4" in depth) through the product's installation holes. http://www.gnrtech.com/img_gnr/parking_curb/ParkIt_Installation2.gif

Step 3

Remove the product; re-drill the holes for the diameter and depth required by the metal shields.

Step 4

Install the metal shields, re-position the product and bolt with lag bolts and washers.

Maintenance

Parking curbs require minimal maintenance. Periodically inspect the bolts and tighten if necessary.
